The Club Champions League (CCL) is excited to conduct events for the 2020-2021 seasonal year using our CCL College Showcase COVID-19 Protocols and Field Maps which have been developed using the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), U.S. Soccer’s Phase III “Play On” Full Team Competitions guidance and in concert with The Virginia Department of Health, Chesterfield Health Department, and the Chesterfield County - RiverCity Sportsplex Risk Management team.

With the support of our member clubs and event participants, the CCL’s number one priority is to establish an event environment that is safe for all players, parents/guardians, coaches, referees, and spectators under The Commonwealth of Virginia’s Phase III Guidelines and Executive Order Sixty-Seven. The CCL’s College Showcase COVID-19 Protocols and Field Maps are provided to assist youth soccer clubs and teams in safely creating a successful event while attempting to reduce infection risk in the setting of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. These protocols do not supersede or replace any applicable local, state, regional or federal health guidelines or requirements, which should be adhered to by all clubs and club members. Equally, these recommendations do not replace any club’s protocols (if they are stronger) and should aid in teams having a successful event experience.

## *SPIRIT OF COOPERATION – SHOWCASE PROTOCOLS*

### **CHESTERFIELD COUNTY - RIVERCITY SPORTSPLEX COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

- Extended cleaning of facility will occur three times per day (Morning, Middle of the Day, Evening)
  - High touch points and restrooms wiped down every hour in addition to deep cleanings
- Separate points of entry and exit into the facility
- Hand sanitizing stations throughout the facility
- Appropriate signage around the entire facility, including social distance guidelines, stay home if you are sick, facial coverings required, and 25 maximum number of spectators per field
- Bleachers and picnic tables are off limits and player benches have been removed
- Facility staff required to wear facial coverings and complete the daily health assessment before coming to work
- Additional staff has been hired (RMC Events) to assist with crowd control
- All facility areas will be monitored to ensure traffic flow, social distancing, and congestion by RiverCity staff, RMC Events staff, and CCL event staff.

### **CCL COLLEGE SHOWCASE - RIVERCITY SPORTSPLEX COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

- Everyone in attendance must complete a self wellness check each day before arriving to the venue (see page 10 for an example).
  - If someone shows signs of COVID-19, do not attend the event.
- Facial coverings are always required for everyone in attendance (excluding participants actively participating in the match).
  - Facial coverings required for players and coaches on the sidelines and during breaks.
  - College coaches required to wear mask.
- Entry and exit points for each field, and specific to the Home and Away teams and their spectators.
- Only 25 spectators allowed per field (not including players, coaches, referees, college coaches, and event staff).
  - 12 colored wristbands will be provided to each team manager at the start of the event to control spectator capacity at each field.
    - Team Managers must check-in with an event official 1-hour prior to the start of the first game.
    - Social distancing required on the sidelines.
- Spectators and participants in transit are not considered part of the maximum 25 spectators per field capacity.
- Spectators and participants not directly at the field are not considered part of the maximum 25 spectators per field capacity.
  - For example, on the hill for Field #1-9, concourse, vendor area, food trucks
- No team tents, tailgating, or congregating in large groups at the facility.



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## *SPIRIT OF COOPERATION – WORKING TOGETHER*

### **CCL COLLEGE SHOWCASE - RIVERCITY SPORTSPLEX COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

- **Warm-up.** Teams playing next may warmup on open portions of the turf fields. However, they must take place far enough away from spectators.
  - Do not arrive to your assigned game field more than 30 minutes prior to your game time.
    - Players, coaches, referees and spectators must wear facial coverings to/from fields.
- **Match.** Facial coverings are required for players, coaches, college coaches, and spectators on sidelines during the match.
  - Coaches and players must exercise social distance on the sidelines.
  - Referees must wear facial coverings to/from fields.
    - Referees waiting for the next match (not actively participating in a match) must wear facial coverings.
- **Halftime.** Facial coverings are required during breaks, including halftime.
  - Teams must exercise social distancing.
- **Post Match.** Teams will need to exit the fields immediately after the completion of a match.
  - Post game team talks must be done off fields and in an open space/area located at the facility.
    - Players, coaches, referees and spectators must wear facial coverings to/from fields.

### **CCL COLLEGE SHOWCASE - RIVERCITY SPORTSPLEX COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

- **General.**
  - Anyone using the port-o-lets or restrooms must wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer provided on-site.
  - All athletic trainers, vendors, and/or other event personnel must wear face coverings.
  - All event staff tents, referee tents, vendor areas, and food trucks must exercise social distancing.
  - Anyone entering a tent must wear a face covering.
  - **DO NOT ATTEND THE EVENT IF YOU ARE SICK OR FEEL SICK.**

Each Home Team (players and spectators) and Away Team (players and spectators) will have their own entry and exit points (see ) except Fields #1-#3 that will share entry and exit point. There is a corner gate to enter and exit. Please use walkways around the fields to access these points so the flow of foot traffic is spread out. We ask that parents sit on the opposite side of their team and social distance on the sideline. Thank you!

- Do you have a fever (has a measured temperature of 100.4 °F [38 °C] or greater)?
- Do you have a cough?
- Do you have shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
- Do you have body aches or muscle pain?
- Do you have a new loss of taste and/or smell?
- Have you been in contact with anyone who is confirmed positive for COVID-19?
- Have you been in contact with anyone who has had a known exposure to COVID-19?

***If you answered YES one or more of the above questions, we ask that you do not attend the event.***
